“Captain Heitmann, Tom to his friends, was a member of the Saint Bede Academy graduating class of 2002 (Peru, Illinois). “While at St. Bede, Tom lettered four years in football with three years in track and one in basketball. He was a part of the most successful football team in the Academy’s history and was inducted with his team into SBA’s Hall of Fame. He was also the 2002 News Tribune Boys Track and Field Athlete of the Year; he still holds two of St. Bede’s track and field records. “Tom was involved in the arts as well; he was a four-year choir member and cast in the Academy’s musicals. “On top of the arts and athletics, Tom was also active in his faith, serving as a Eucharistic minister at the Academy and participating in TEC (Teens Encounter Christ).

“In honor of our good friend, the Saint Bede Academy graduating class of 2002 is working towards a dedication gift to the Academy as a memorial in Tom’s name. “Plans are underway to purchase a new scoreboard for the football field, including a plaque immortalizing our fallen friend, Captain Thomas John Heitmann.”

R.I.P. Bernie Maurer.....Mike Lentz, Central Minnesota TEC

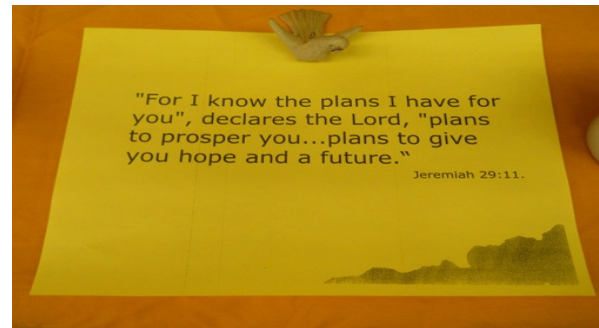
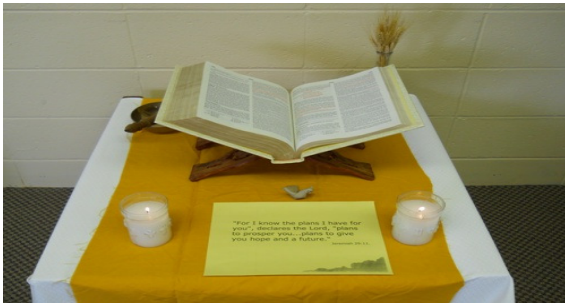
Happy Rise Day Bernie Maurer! Bernie (age 81) passed away Tuesday, January 18 in Little Falls. The Mass of Christian Burial was held Monday, January 23 at 11 AM at St. Mary’s Catholic Church in Little Falls.

There are a handful of people/families that are responsible for TEC’s success and growth in the early years. Bernie, along with his wife Helen, were very instrumental to TEC’s establishment in the late 70’s and early 80’s. The majority of the Maurer family made TEC weekends and worked on dozens and dozens of weekends.

Bernie made CM 3 and then returned to direct the wheat team on CM 4 and 5. He served as an assistant lay director on CM 6 and then directed the conference room with his wife, Helen, at least 10 times over the next 18 months. Quite simply, the Maurer family set a tone of care and service that has been part of TEC ever since. They called forth and mentored new directors who in turn trained many of our current directors. Bernie and Helen directed my first TEC weekend and I have many fond memories of working with Bernie, Helen and many of the Maurer family members.
