- Cleaning out the garage, closet or a toy box. While doing that, have a prayerful conversation with the Lord about cleaning up our own lives.
- Find a comfortable chair or a quiet place inside or out with some prayer things there. Make a date with God and go to this place often.
- Use of family pictures or connecting with the family tree can give you the time to pray specifically for them, their potential, their dreams and the challenges they are encountering. Also, with the family tree we can pray for those who passed on the faith to us.
- Make today the off button day and spend time in silence listening to God's plan instead of the TV, radio, computer, or cell phone. Just being with God is good enough.

I'm sure all of you can share many similar or better examples to deepen our Lenten experience. Before you know Holy Week will be here, and the celebration of the Holy Triduum will lead us to Easter Sunday and new life.

The use of ordinary things in our daily lives can help us rediscover our faith, and lead us as a family to join all Christians around the world on Easter Sunday in the life-giving prayer: **Alleluia! Jesus is risen!**
